## **Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 (as** amended). Application for a variation of permit conditions. Permit reference EP/20090004

Thank you for applying for a variation of permit conditions for permit reference EP/20090004/V1 at site location; Quays and Jetties of Immingham Dock, under the above legislation.

The application was received on the 10<sup>th</sup> July 2014. I have examined the documents and accepted the application as 'duly made'. I may need to contact you again for further information after a more detailed study of the application during the period of determination.

The above application received for a variation of permit conditions proposes to include the unloading of cement clinker to quayside for subsequent haulage to a permanent storage site off the Port Estate. As discussed, I would agree to allow for a trial discharge of cement clinker to guayside to determine whether the cement clinker will be a suitable product for Associated British Ports to handle at the Port of Immingham and dust control methods to employ. An officer from NELC will be present during the trial, the date of the said trial shall be submitted in writing to the Environment Team for approval prior to commencement of the discharge.
