Non-Technical Summary

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The company will be operating a timber treatment facility at Immingham Dock. The facility receives our timber and more from 3rd parties and applies a treatment process to preserve the timber from insect attack and also moisture / water damage. Two treatment processes are offered at the facility with one being used to preserve constructional timber used in roof trusses and timber frame houses, and the other designed to treat timbers for use in non-dry areas such as fence panels and fence posts. There are no active discharges of chemicals on the site. Treatment chemicals arrive in tankers and are transferred to the storage tanks in a sealed operation. Storage tanks are undercover and contained within bunded walls to contain any leaks. The treatment tank operation is carried out with the tanks contained within bunded walls. Treated packs are stored outside when essentially dry so there is no significant release of chemicals to the environment.
