# 3. The relevant planning permission

The relevant planning permission to which this notice relates is the permission granted by the Council on the 8<sup>th</sup> September 2011 as per approved planning application no. DC/487/11/SOU (attached hereto).

#### 4. The breach of conditions

The following conditions have not been complied with:-

#### Condition 4

'The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the following approved plans: 530/1 (received 14th June 2011), 530/2 and 530/3 (received 23rd June 2011).

#### Reason

For the avoidance of doubt and in the interests of proper planning.'

## 5. What you are required to do

As the person responsible for the breach of condition specified in paragraph 4 of this notice, you are required to comply with the stated conditions by taking the following steps:-

## Requirement No. 1

Remove all works that have not been completed in full accordance with the approved plans stated above (copies of the relevant plans are appended to this notice) and ensure that any further works are carried out in accordance with said plans.

## Time for Compliance:

### Requirement No. 1

3 months from the date this notice takes effect.

This notice takes effect immediately it is served on you or you receive it by postal delivery.
