LISTED BUILDING ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY: NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE COUNCIL

1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to the Council that works have been carried out to the listed building described in paragraph 2 of this notice in contravention of section 7 of the above Act. The Council considers that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the effect of the works on the character of the building as being of special architectural or historic interest. The annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. THE LAND AFFECTED

44 Alexandra Road, Cleethorpes, North East Lincolnshire ("the land")

3. <u>THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH</u> OF PLANNING CONTROL

- 1. The removal of timber guttering, fascia board and eaves brackets and replacement with plastic guttering and plain timber fascia at the front of the property.
- 2. The boarding up of the glass over light above the first floor door at the front of the property

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

The plastic guttering and unsympathetic plain timber fascia as well as the boarding of the glass over light, by reason of the design and materials used, are out of character with, and detrimental to, the appearance of this grade II listed building. The Council does not believe that Listed Building Consent should be granted for these alterations because they adversely affect the appearance and character of the Listed Building. Conditions could not overcome these objections.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- 1. Remove plastic gutter
- 2. Replace timber fascia board to match exactly the depth, width, height and profile of the adjacent fascia board to the eaves of No.45 Alexandra Road
- 3. Replace timber eaves cornice gutter to match exactly the detail on No.45 Alexandra Road (as per Photograph no.1 – below). Note: in the interests of longevity a lining is advised using either lead or bitumen)
- 4. Repair and re-fix the 2 existing eaves brackets (2 no. retained on site) to original location (one each side of window A marked on Photograph No. 1 appended to this Notice).
- 5. Refix to the right of the window (as indicated as Window B marked on photograph no. 1 appended to this notice) 1 no. matching eaves bracket, to match exactly in all respects the 2 existing currently on the building.
- 6. Paint the timber eaves cornice gutter following completion of works in black gloss paint.
- 7. Remove painted board from over light to Window C marked on Photograph No.1 appended to this Notice.
- 8. Reinstate plain glass over light to Window C marked on Photograph No. 1 appended to this Notice.

6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

1 month after this notice takes effect. (17 June 2013)

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

> This notice takes effect on May 2013 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.
