1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to it that there has been a breach of planning control, under section 171A(1)(a) of the above act, at the land described below. It considers that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

#### 2. THE LAND AFFECTED

Land at 8-12 Wellowgate, Grimsby, North East Lincolnshire shown edged red on the attached plan ("the land")

# 3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, the use of the first floor to the rear of the land as a House in Multiple Occupation.

### 4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It appears that the breach of the above planning control has occurred within the last four years.

The use of the land as a House in Multiple Occupation, due to inadequate size of rooms, poor layout of the first floor to the rear of the land and inadequate amenity space provides for substandard accommodation contrary to saved Policy H13 of the North East Lincolnshire Local Plan 2003.

The Council do not consider that planning permission should be given because planning conditions could not overcome these objections.

#### 5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Remove the accommodation sited on the first floor to the rear of the development and cease the use as a House in Multiple Occupation.
