THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to the Council that there has been a breach of planning control, under section 171A(1)(a) of the above act, at the land described below. The Council considers that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The annex at the end of the notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

#### 2. THE LAND AFFECTED

Land at Killearn, Clee Village, Old Clee, Grimsby, North East Lincolnshire shown edged red on the attached plan ("the land")

# 3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission the erection of a raised platform including railings and associated steps for access on the detached garage shown in blue on the attached plan ('the raised platform, railings and steps').

#### 4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It appears that the breach of the above planning control has occurred within the last four years.

The raised platform, railings and steps by reason of their position, size, mass and design is to the detriment of the residential and visual amenity of the character and appearance of the area and is thus contrary to saved Policy GEN1 of the North East Lincolnshire Local Plan 2003.

The Council does not consider that planning permission should be given because planning conditions could not overcome these objections.

### 5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Remove the raised platform, railings and steps from the above property known as Killearn, Clee Village, Old Clee, Grimsby, North East Lincolnshire.

# 6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

28 days after this notice takes effect.

# 7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on states an appeal is made against it beforehand.


### YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL
