## 3. The relevant planning permission

The relevant planning permission to which this notice relates is the permission granted by the Council on the 12<sup>th</sup> December 2007 as per approved planning application no. DC/742/07/WMA (attached hereto).

#### 4. The breach of conditions

The following conditions have not been complied with:-

#### Condition 1

The use of the land as an outside seating area or drinking area shall cease and no seats, tables or screens shall be in a position at any time after  $15^{th}$  June 2009.

## 5. What you are required to do

As the person responsible for the breach of condition specified in paragraph 4 of this notice, you are required to comply with the stated conditions by taking the following steps:-

Remove all seats, tables and screens from the land to the front of the premises named above.
