This is a formal Notice, which is issued by the Council, under Section 187A of the above Act, because the Council considers that a condition imposed on a grant of planning permission relating to the land described below, has not been complied with. The Council considers that you should be required to secure compliance with the condition specified in this Notice.

2. The land affected by the Notice

The premises and land at 117 Barnoldby Road, Waltham, North East Lincolnshire.

3. The relevant planning permission

The relevant planning permission to which this Notice relates is the permission granted by the Council on the 7th December 2001 (attached hereto).

4. The breach of condition

The following conditions have not been complied with:-

Condition 6 of planning application no. DC/1073/01/WOL, which states:

Condition

Development shall not begin on the site, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority, until the within highway works to Barnoldby Road footpath extension have been laid out in accordance with Drawing No RD.1284.02A and completed to the satisfaction of the Local Planning Authority in accordance with comprehensive engineering details to be submitted and approved by the Local Planning Authority before such works are commenced.

5. What you are required to do

As the owner of the property specified in paragraph 2 of this Notice, you are required to comply with the stated conditions by taking the following steps:-

Requirement No. 1

Submit comprehensive engineering details of the footpath that is to be constructed at the front of your property.

Requirement No.2

Complete the footpath at the front of the property, named in paragraph 2 of this Notice, to join up with the existing footpath on Barnoldby Road, Waltham, and in the position as outlined in the approved plans of application no. DC/1073/01/WOL. The footpath should be to the specifications as outlined in the engineering report submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority.

Time for Compliance:

Requirement No. 1

One month after this Notice takes effect

Requirement No. 2

Three months after this Notice takes effect

6. When this Notice takes effect

This Notice takes effect immediately it is served on you or you receive it by postal delivery.
