THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, under Section 171A(1)(a) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations.

### 2. THE LAND AFFECTED

The land at The Hall, Ashby Cum Fenby, North East Lincolnshire, shown edged red on the attached plan ("the land").

# 3. THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL

Without planning permission, the erection of a tennis court on the land, measuring 34.20 metres by 17.20 metres approximately.

### 4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last four years. In the opinion of the Local Planning Authority the unauthorised development represents an unacceptable encroachment into, and detracts from the character and appearance of, an area of open countryside and is contrary to Policy GEN2 in the Revised deposit draft of the North East Lincolnshire Local Plan.

### 4. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Remove the tennis court and associated fencing from the land and restore the land to its condition before the tennis court was erected.

## 6. TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

28 days after this notice takes effect.

## 7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on the 8th April 2002 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.



Stop using the tennis court and restore the land to its condition before the tennis court was erected.

28 days after this notice takes effect.


