2	Minutes and matters arising Minutes were approved, seconded and agreed. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The revised SACRE Constitution had been submitted to NELC and approved • The revised Code of Conduct had been submitted to NELC and approved • The evaluation of the SACRE, using the NASACRE tool, was an agenda item for this meeting – see Item 6 • An additional powerpoint presentation on assessment had been received from Lat Blaylock and forwarded to all who attended the Great RE 2015 event. • JH clarified that the work of supporting the SACRE reverts to NELC as of 1st April 2016. Details of what form this will take and who will pick up the role of Clerk and LA Link have not yet been finalised. • Details for the syllabus launch event in Hull on 17th March have been confirmed and all members were invited to attend. Note: Since this meeting, the initial payment of £800 was made to ERYC for the work on publishing the syllabus to the shared website.	
3	Syllabus Review Copies of additional sections of the syllabus were circulated for consideration, seeking approval and endorsement for their inclusion in the final syllabus: Introduction; Purpose of RE – national guidance; Religious education, SMSC and British values; Developing Knowledge, Skills and Attitudes in RE JC reported on current progress. Cornwall have given permission for their document on Qualities to be fostered in religious education (distributed) to be used with the Humber syllabus. GG raised the necessity to review KS4 guidance in light of recent DfE guidance. KB queried some wording in the draft and agreed to email proposed amendments to JC prior to the next working group meeting.
