DOGS ON LEADS BYELAWS

PIER GARDENS, CLEETHORPES

DOGS ON LEADS

Byelaws made by the Council of the Borough of Cleethorpes 'under Section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875.

INTERPRETATION

1. In these byelaws:

'the Council' means the Council of the Borough of Cleethorpes

'the Grounds" means the Pier Gardens, Cleethorpes

DOGS ON LEADS

- (i) No person shall, without reasonable excuse, permit a dog to enter or remain in the grounds unless the dog is held on a lead and is restrained from behaviour giving reasonable grounds for annoyance.
 - (ii) Notice of the effect of these byelaws shall be given signs placed in conspicuous positions on the approaches to the grounds.
- 3. (i) For the purpose of these byelaws the keeper of the dog shall be deemed in charge thereof, unless the court is satisfied that at the time when the dog was present on the promenade without being held on a lead it had been placed in or taken into the charge of some other person.
 - (ii) In paragraph (i) above "the keeper" shall include the owner of the dog or any person who habitually has it in his possession.

REMOVAL

4. Any person offending against these byelaws may be removed from the grounds by any officer of the Council or any Constable.

PENALTY

5. Any person offending against these byelaws shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.

REVOCATION

6. CLAUSE 13 (i) OF THE BYELAWS IN SO FAR AS IT RELATES TO THE PLEASURE GROUND KNOWN AS PIER GARDENS WHICH WERE MADE BY THE BOROUGH OF CLEETHORPES ON THE 20TH DAY OF NOVEMBER 1963 AND CONFIRMED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE AS COMING INTO OPERATION ON THE 23RD DAY OF MARCH 1964 IS HEREBY REPEALED.
