BYELAW

MADE UNDER Section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875 by the Great Grimsby Borough Council with respect to the Pleasure Ground known as Sutherland Park.

1. THE byelaws made by the Great Grimsby Borough Council on the 11th day of February 1983 and confirmed by the Secretary of State on the 8th day of June 1983 relating to Pleasure Grounds within the said Borough are hereby extended as follows:-
2. THE aforesaid byelaws shall be extended to the pleasure ground known as Sutherland Park which name shall be added to the Schedule to the aforesaid byelaws and the series read and construed accordingly.
