






The purpose of this consultation is to understand from residents of Grimsby where you want to see the town centre in 10 years' time.

Grimsby was the first town in England to secure investment from Government for improvements in the town centre. Consultation feedback from 2018 was used to develop the first phase of investments that have already started in the town centre, including public realm works at both St James Square, and near Frederick Ward Way and Garth Lane, as well as the refurbishment of Corporation Bridge due to start later this year. A vision to redevelop the western end of Victoria Street is also being developed with a bid to Government for Future High Street Funding this month.

The Government has now extended the 'Towns Fund' programme which means Grimsby can bid again for further funding to invest in the town centre over the next five years. We are also considering what Grimsby might look like after COVID-19 and how funding can be directed towards projects to help with economic and social recovery.

We have started to develop a plan for how the town centre could change in the future. This plan, known as the Grimsby Town Centre Masterplan, will help us decide which ideas to put forward for funding, both from the Towns Fund and other sources of public funding. It will also help guide the Council's future investment decisions over the next 10 years or more.
