

**THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL (B1210) (40MPH
SPEED LIMIT) (NO.19-21) ORDER 2020.**

Notice is hereby given that the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, propose to make a Road Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the effect of which will be as follows:-

1. To extend the current 40mph on the B1210 on its westerly approach to Healing Village by a distance of 300 metres.
