## A1098 HEWITTS AVENUE LAYBY, GRIMSBY (TEMPORARY CLOSURE – TTRO 19-134) ORDER 2019

<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), the Highway Authority for the aforementioned highway in the Borough of North East Lincolnshire, is satisfied that a temporary prohibition be imposed because of the likelihood of danger to the public for eighteen months.

The extents of the closure will be:

HEWITTS AVENUE LAYBY (A1098) located between Peaks Lane and Humberston Road - Its entire length.

The closure is anticipated to take place from the Twelfth of December 2019 to the Eleventh of June 2021.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:

- 1. A temporary highway closure (because of the likelihood of danger to the public) to the Layby on HEWITTS AVENUE (A1098), Grimsby.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Order will come into operation on **Thursday 12 December 2019** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.
- 4. The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (HEWITTS AVENUE LAYBY, GRIMSBY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC TTRO 19-134) ORDER 2019
