Statement of Reasons

This Statement of Reasons relates to the making of the following Traffic Regulation Order:

The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Energy Park Way) (Clearway) (No. 19-20B) Order 2020.

Street(s) affected:

Energy Park Way (Humber Bank Link Road)

Ward(s) affected:

Wolds

Proposal:

To introduce a 24-hour Clearway along ENERGY PARK WAY (HUMBER BANK LINK ROAD), from its junction with MOODY LANE in a North Westerly direction to the South-Eastern extremity of HOBSON WAY

Reason:

Upon the completion of the new Link Road, it will provide a free-flowing alternative route to the South Humber Bank Industrial Area, which removes the need to travel along a high-speed dual carriageway road (A180).

Evidence suggests that when traffic is travelling at constant speeds, even at a lower level, it may result in shorter and more reliable overall journey times. In order to support this it is necessary to remove any potential obstruction to traffic flow by prohibiting the stopping of vehicles within the carriageway.

There is sufficient carriageway width to allow for the passage of a stationary vehicle, due to breakdown or emergency, however, parking or stopping on the carriageway is not desirable or sanctioned for the reasons given above.
