## The North East LincoInshire Borough Council (Prohibition of Waiting Restrictions)(Freeman Street, Grimsby) (No. 20-13) Order 2020

Notice is hereby given that on the **25<sup>th</sup> November 2020** North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Road Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the effect of which is as follows:-

## Freeman Street

- 1. To revoke a section of the 'No Waiting Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm' (Single Yellow Line) restriction on the eastern kerbline from its junction with Kent Street.
- 2. To revoke a section of the "Limited waiting 30 minutes, no return within 30 minutes Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm" parking bay situated on the eastern kerbline, between its junctions with Kent Street and Church Street.
- 3. To introduce a "Prohibition of Waiting: No Waiting at Any Time" (Double Yellow Line) restriction on the eastern kerbline from its junction with Kent Street.

## Kent Street

- 1. To revoke a section of the 'No Waiting Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm' restriction on the southern kerb line from its junction with Freeman Street.
- 2. To introduce a "Prohibition of Waiting: No Waiting at Any Time" (Double Yellow Line) restriction on the southern kerbline from its junction with Freeman Street.

The Order will come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2021.
