THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a) A SECTION OF CLEE ROAD, CLEETHORPES (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– TTRO 20-125) ORDER 2020

<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle to proceed along the below sections of highway:

 OVERNIGHT - A section of A46 Clee Road – Part Length from its junction with CLEE CRESCENT to its junction with A1098 GRIMSBY ROAD

Alternative route: A1098 ISAACS HILL, A1098 HIGH STREET, A1098 ALEXANDRA ROAD, A1098 HIGH CLIFFE, A1098 KINGSWAY, A1098 QUEENS PARADE, A1098 TAYLORS AVENUE, A1031 HUMBERSTON ROAD, A46 CLEE ROAD

This temporary prohibition is requited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by North East Lincolnshire Council. These works are detailed as traffic signal upgrade project and resurfacing.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation at **19:00hrs** on **Monday, 09 November 2020** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

• Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
