- I require proof by way of a recognised agent or solicitor that the business and any lease agreements for the premises have been transferred and what date
- I require proof of the amount the business and lease agreement was sold for
- I require proof that the funds for the business have been transferred from yourself to the previous owner's bank account
- I require confirmation that the previous owner no longer has any involvement in the running of the premises.

The police only have a short time to process this application. It is expected that these details should be readily available given the application to transfer the premises licence.
