

The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council
(Prohibition of Movement)
(Marklew Avenue, Grimsby)
(No. 19-06) Order 2021

Notice is hereby given that on the **18th February 2021** North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Road Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the effect of which is as follows:-

1. Prohibit all vehicles that are exiting Marklew Avenue from turning right onto Cromwell Road.

The Order will come into force on the **9th March 2021**.

If any person wishes to challenge the validity of this Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is, or they are, not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act, has not been complied with, that person may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
