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Your bill explained

1. this shows the date the bill was issued
2. this is the address the bill was sent to
3. this is the address the bill refers to
4. this is your council tax account number. You need to quote this whenever you call or write about your bill
5. this is the barcode you will need if you make payments at the post office or at paypoint outlets
6. this shows how the full charge for your property has been made up. It shows much is for the council, the adult social care precept, the charge for the area or parish your property is in, the charges for the police and fire services – these form part of your bill but are not set or controlled by the council
7. this is the percentage change in the charges since last year
8. this is the area or parish you live in
9. this is the unique property reference for your property
10. this is the reason your bill was produced (for example, an annual bill or a change to your discounts)
11. this is valuation band your property
12. this is the period your bill covers
13. this is the explanation for any reductions due to discounts or exemptions
14. **this is the amount you must pay this year**
15. these are the dates your instalments are due
16. this is the amount of your first instalment
17. this is the amount of your remaining instalments
18. these are the payment options you can use
