The Council of the Borough of North East Lincolnshire, hereinafter referred to as "the Council", in exercise of powers conferred on the Council under Sections 1(1) and 2(2) to (3) inclusive, 4(2) 32(1) and 35(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order

2.01	In this C assigned	Order all expressions, except as otherwise herein provided, shall have the meanings d to them by the Act of 1984 :
	(1)	"appointed hackney carriage stand" means a stand for hackney carriages appointed under Section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;
	(2)	"approved timing point" is the location where a public service vehicle may wait to ensure adherence to a published timetable or local service registration, and includes departure and terminal points provided that the location and service(s) have been approved in writing by the Highway Authority as subject to amendment in writing by the Highway Authority;
	(3)	"bus and pedal cycle lane" means
		 (a) any area of carriageway of a specified road intended for the passage of both buses and pedal cycles, which is comprised within and indicated by traffic sign complying with diagram 1049 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and placed on the carriageway; and
		(b) that part of the public highway listed in Schedule 6.01 to this Order;
		(c) without prejudice to the generality of paragraphs 2.01(3)(a) and (b) abov where the traffic sign marking the boundary of the bus and pedal cycle lane is broken by a gap opposite and adjacent to the junction of a specific road with any other road or an accessway or at a pedestrian crossing or b a street refuge the boundary shall nevertheless be regarded as continuing unbroken;
		(d) in this Order a reference to an adjacent part of the road is a reference to a area that is not within the bus and pedal cycle lane but is within the carriageway of the length of road which comprises the bus and pedal cyclane;
	(4)	"bus, taxi, motor cycle and pedal cycle lane" means
		 (a) any area of carriageway of a specified road intended for the passage of buses, hackney carriages, motor cycles and pedal cycles, which is comprised within and indicated by a traffic sign complying with diagram 1049 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and placed on the carriageway; and
		(b) that part of the public highway listed in Schedule 6.02 to this Order;

without prejudice to the generality of paragraphs 2.01(2)(a) and (b) above, where the traffic sign marking the boundary of the bus and pedal cycle "Tane is broken by a gap opposite and adjacent to the junction of a specified road with any other road or an accessway or at a pedestrian crossing or by a street refuge the boundary shall nevertheless be regarded as continuing unbroken;

- (d) in this Order a reference to an adjacent part of the road is a reference to an area that is not within the bus, taxi, motor cycle and pedal cycle lane but is within the carriageway of the length of road which comprises the bus, taxi, motor cycle and pedal cycle lane;
- (5) "carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in the road being a way (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles;
- (6) "cycle lane" means
 - (a) any area of carriageway of a specified road intended for the passage of pedal cycles, which is comprised within and indicated by a traffic sign complying with either diagram 1049 or diagram 1049.1 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and placed on the carriageway; and
 - (b) that part of the public highway listed in Schedule 6.03 to this Order
- "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;
- (8) disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;
- (9) "goods" includes postal packets of any description, and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;
- (10) "hackney carriage" has the same meaning as in the Town Police Clauses Act 1847;
- (11) "local service" has the same meaning as in Section 2 of the Transport Act 1985;
- (12) "parking disc" means a disc issued by a local authority complying with the requirements of the British Standards Specification for Parking Discs (B.S. No. 6571-7:1997) coloured blue, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which waiting begins;
- (13) pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;
- (14) "public service vehicle" has the same meaning as defined in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 and any reference in this Order to a public service vehicle includes such a vehicle being used on a "local service" or a "non local service" as defined in Section 2 of the Transport Act 1985;
- (15) **"reserved traffic lane**" means, for the purpose of this Order, either a bus and pedal cycle lane or a bus, taxi, motor cycle and pedal cycle lane or a cycle lane;
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- (16)"stage carriage" has the same meaning as defined in Section 2(1)(a) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;
- telecommunications apparatus" has the same meaning as defined in the (17)Telecommunications Act 1984;

For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying :-

- a disabled person's badge in the "relevant position" when :-(1)
 - in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is (a) exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen;
 - in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge is (b) exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle;
- a parking disc in the "relevant position" when the disc is exhibited thereon with the (2)side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest the kerb.
- For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be deemed to wait for more than two minutes in the same place if any one part of the road is below any part of the vehicle or its load (if any) throughout a period exceeding two minutes whether or not the vehicle is moved during that period.

3 **Restrictions on Manoeuvre**

3.01 **One-Way Streets**

No person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along any of the roads or lengths of road specified in Column 1 and Column 2 of Schedule 3.01 to this Order, otherwise than in the direction specified in Column 3 of the said Schedule.

Prohibited Turns

No person shall except on the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3.02 to this Order to turn into the length of road specified opposite in Column 2 of the said Schedule in the direction specified in Column 3 of the said Schedule.

3.03 No Entry

Save as provided by Article 8.01 to this Order no person shall except on the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3.03 to this Order to enter the length of roads specified opposite in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

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3.04 Prohibited U Turns

No person shall except on the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in one of the length of roads specified in Schedule 3.04 to this Order so that it describes a U turn in order to proceed in the opposite direction.

3.05 Mandatory Turns

Every person causing or permitting a vehicle to proceed along a road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3.05 to this Order shall cause or permit that vehicle on reaching the junction of that road with the road specified opposite in Column 2 of the said Schedule to this Order in relation to that road to make a turn into the road specified in Column 2 in the direction indicated in Column 3 of the said Schedule.

Prohibition of Vehicles (by Class)

4.01 Prohibition of Driving

No person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any length of road specified in Schedule 4.01 to this Order.

4.03

Prohibition of Driving Except For Access

Save as provided by Articles 8.02 and 8.03 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.02 to this Order.

Prohibition of Driving Except for Loading

Save as provided by Article 8.02 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.03 to this Order save for the purpose of loading or unloading of goods within the areas of land specified in Column 3 of the said Schedule.

4.04

Prohibition of Driving Except for Buses, Taxis and Loading

Save as provided by Article 8.04 to this Order no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle other than a public service vehicle or a hackney carriage to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.04 to this Order.

4.05

Prohibition of Pedal Cycling

No person shall ride or cause to be ridden any pedal cycle on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.05 to this Order.

5 Prohibition of Vehicles (by Dimension)

5.01 7.5 Tonnes Weight Limit, Except for Access

Save as provided by Articles 8.05, 8.06 and 8.07 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicle to proceed in any road specified in Schedule 5.01 to this Order.

5.02 7.5 Tonnes Weight Limit, Except for Loading

Save as provided by Article 8.05 and 8.07 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicle to proceed in any road specified in Schedule 5.02 to this Order.

5.03 Height Restriction

No person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle, the height of which, inclusive of any load on the vehicle, exceeds that specified in Column 3 of Schedule 5.03 to this Order, to proceed in that length of road specified in Column 1 and Column 2 to the said Schedule.

Bus and Pedal Cycle Facilities

Bus and Pedal Cycle Lanes

Save as provided in Article 8.08 and 8.09 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any motor vehicle other than a vehicle used in the provision of a local service, public service vehicle, stage carriage or pedal cycle, between the hours specified in column 4 of Schedule 6.01 to this Order, to enter, proceed along or wait in the bus and pedal cycle lane specified in the said Schedule, otherwise than for the purpose of crossing it.

6.02

Bus, Taxi, Motor Cycle and Pedal Cycle Lanes

Save as provided in Article 8.08 and 8.09 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any motor vehicle other than a vehicle used in the provision of a local service, public service vehicle, stage carriage or hackney carriage or motor cycle or pedal cycle, between the days specified in column 4 of Schedule 6.02 to this Order and between the hours specified in column 5 of the said Schedule, to enter, proceed along or wait in the bus, taxi, motor cycle and pedal cycle lane specified in the said Schedule, otherwise than for the purpose of crossing it.

6.03

Cycle Lanes

Save as provided by Articles 8.08 and 8.09 to this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a pedal cycle to enter, wait or proceed in any cycle lane specified in Schedule 6.03 to this Order, otherwise for the purpose of crossing it.

7 Pedestrian Streets

Full Time Pedestrian Streets

Save as provided by Article 8.10 to this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a hand cart, perambulator or pedal cycle pushed by hand to proceed at any time within the roads specified in Schedule 7.01 to this Order.

Core Time Pedestrian Streets

Save as provided by Article 8.10 to this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a hand cart, perambulator or pedal cycle pushed by hand to proceed at any time within the roads specified in Schedule 7.02 (hereinafter called the "restricted area") to this Order provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent any person from causing a vehicle to proceed in the restricted area between the hours of 4.00 pm and midnight and midnight and 10.30 am.

- for the purpose of gaining access to any premises fronting, adjoining, abutting or situated adjacent to the restricted area where no suitable alternative means of access is available;
- (2) if the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle carrying a disabled person;

PROVIDED in both cases a permit has been granted by or by authority of the Council and it is **FURTHER PROVIDED** that the driver of a vehicle shall move the vehicle on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction.

No Waiting At Any Time (Restricted Area)

Save as provided by Articles 8.11 and 8.12 to this Order no person shall at any time on any day of the week cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road or on any of the sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 7.03 to this Order.

- (3) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packages as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (4) the vehicle to proceed in the road as part of a wedding or funeral processional party;
- (5) the vehicle to be used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- (6) the vehicle to be loaded or unloaded.

Nothing in Article 4.02 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the roads referred to in that Article to enable the vehicle to be used by persons gaining access to any premises fronting, adjoining, abutting or situated adjacent to the roads where no suitable alternative means of access is available.

Nothing in Article 4.04 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit :

- vehicles to be loaded and unloaded. PROVIDED that the vehicle shall approach from Victoria Street West and travel in a northerly direction through the area
- (2) any vehicle to be used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

Nothing in Articles 5.01 and 5.02 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle referred to in those Articles to proceed in the roads referred to in those Articles if the vehicle is being used :

- (1) in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, of any of the following operations, namely :
 - (a) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (c) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road;
 - (d) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjoining to the road, of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus;
- (2) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (3) the vehicle to be used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

Nothing in Article 5.01 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle referred to in that Article to proceed in the roads referred to in that Article if the vehicle is to be garaged, serviced or repaired at any premises situated on or adjacent to that road.

8.07 Nothing in Articles 5.01 and 5.02 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle referred to in those Articles to proceed in the roads referred to in those Articles if the vehicle is being used for the conveyance of goods or merchandise from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road.

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Nothing in Articles 6.01 and 6.02 to this Order shall render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to enter, wait or proceed in the reserved traffic lane so far as any such entry or proceeding is reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to :

- be used for the removal or avoidance of any obstruction to traffic;
- (2) be used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (3) be used in the service of any local authority, water authority or the Post Office or with the permission of any such authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or in connection with the supply of gas or electricity, or any telecommunication apparatus. *PROVIDED* that whilst being so used it is necessary for the vehicle to wait in the reserved traffic lane;
- (4) avoid an accident;
- (5) gain access to or egress from off-street loading facilities or garaging adjacent to or accessible only from the reserved traffic lane;
- (6) load or unload any goods or burden at premises adjacent to or accessible only from the reserved traffic lane. PROVIDED that such loading can be reasonably carried out only from the reserved traffic lane and that it takes place only whilst no prohibition of loading and unloading in the reserved traffic lane by virtue of any other Article to this Order or by any other Order is in force
- (7) be used for the boarding or alighting of any person. PROVIDED that such boarding or alighting does not cause the vehicle to wait in the same place for more than two minutes and that no prohibition of loading and unloading in the reserved traffic lane by virtue of any other Article to this Order or by any other Order is in force.

Nothing in Articles 6.01 and 6.02 to this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle or gulley emptying machine or to anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden.

Nothing in Articles 7.01 and 7.02 to this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed in the specified roads if the vehicle is being used :

- (1) for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (2) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjoining to the roads, of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus;
- in the service of a local authority, water authority or Post Office in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (4) for the delivery of valuable goods;
- (5) for the purpose of loading and unloading the vehicle whilst the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture to or from premises fronting, adjoining, abutting or situated adjacent to the specified roads where no suitable alternative means of access is available except where such removal of furniture is being carried out in the normal course of the trade being carried on at the premises;
- (6) in connection with any funeral;

- in connection with a doctors professional duties and carries the badge issued by the British Medical Association;
- (8) for the purposes in respect of which exemption from the provisions of Articles 7.01 and 7.02 to this Order has been granted by or by authority of the Council or the Chief Officer of Police;
- (9) in connection with building operations, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the restricted area if notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the Chief Officer of Police, his consent is obtained, and such conditions as he may impose are complied with.

Nothing in Article 7.03 to this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle referred to in Article 8.10 to wait in any lengths of road referred to in Article 7.03 either upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden or for as long as may be necessary in connection with the purposes referred to in Article 8.10. **PROVIDED** that the driver of a vehicle shall move the vehicle on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden whenever such moving may be necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction.

Nothing in Article 7.03 to this Order shall :

- (1) prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle referred to in Article 7.02 (1) (being a vehicle permitted to enter the restricted area) to wait in any of the lengths of road within the restricted area for so long as may be necessary in conjunction with the purposes referred to in Article 7.02 (1).
- (2) render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle referred to in Article 7.02 (2) which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, the Council permit and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the lengths of road within the restricted area for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle) in the same length of road. *PROVIDED that the driver of a vehicle shall move the vehicle on the instruction of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden whenever such moving may be necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction.*

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9	Miscellaneous
9.01	Non Derogation of Restrictions or Requirements
	The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition and not in derogation of the provisions of any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or under any other enactment.
9.02	Interpretation Act
	The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
