The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Bus Lane Revocation & Introduction of Prohibition of Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Scartho Road, Grimsby) (No. 19-05B) Order 2021

Notice is hereby given that on 29 March 2021 North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of which will be to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of Experimental Traffic Regulation Order (ETRO) 19-05A, by permanently: -

- Removing the Bus, Taxi, Motorcycle and Pedal Cycle Lane on Scartho Road, Grimsby between its junction with Matthew Telford Park and Nuns Corner Roundabout.
- 2. Revoking existing 'No Waiting' restrictions along a section of Scartho Road, between its roundabout junction with the A46 LACEBY ROAD / BARGATE and the junction of CONYERS AVENUE (both kerblines).
- Introducing No Waiting at Any Time restrictions along the Easterly kerbline of Scartho Road between the Southerly kerbline of Bargate and Northerly kerbline of Conyers Avenue.
- 4. Introducing No Loading restrictions along a section of the Easterly kerbline of Scartho Road between the Southerly kerbline of Bargate and Northerly kerbline of Conyers Avenue. This restriction will prevent loading in the above sections of road Monday to Friday between the hours of 6-10am and 3-7pm.
- 5. Introducing No Waiting at Any Time restrictions along the Westerly kerbline of Scartho Road between its roundabout junction with A46 Laceby Road and Conyers Avenue.
- 6. Introducing No Loading restrictions along a section of the Westerly kerbline of Scartho Road between its roundabout junction with A46 Laceby Road and Conyers Avenue. This restriction will prevent loading in the above sections of road Monday to Friday between the hours of 6-10am and 3-7pm.

The Order will come into force on the 02 April 2021.

If any person wishes to challenge the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
