Statement of Reasons

This Statement of Reasons relates to the making of the following Traffic Regulation Order:

The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Bus Lane Revocation & Introduction of Prohibition of Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Scartho Road, Grimsby) (No. 19-05B) Order 2021

Street(s) affected:

A1243 Scartho Road, Grimsby

Ward(s) affected:

· Park, Scartho, South

Proposal:

To permanently remove the existing 'Bus, Taxi, Motorcycle and Pedal Cycle Lane' along Scartho Road (A1243) between its junctions with Matthew Telford Park and Nuns Corner roundabout.

Introduce 24hr Prohibition of Waiting (No Waiting: At Any Time) restrictions along both kerblines of the A1243 Scartho Road, between its junctions with Matthew Telford Park and Nuns Corner roundabout.

Introduce No Loading restrictions which operate Monday to Friday between the hours of 6-10am & 3-7pm along both kerblines of the A1243 Scartho Road, between its junctions with Matthew Telford Park and Nuns Corner roundabout

Reason:

Following a review of the impact of ETRO 19-05A officers have concluded that the temporary removal of the bus lane has not increased congestion levels or increased journey times for road users, particularly during peak morning hours.

Similarly, the supplementary 'No Waiting' and 'No Loading' restrictions introduced alongside the removal of the bus lane have not negatively impacted queue lengths or journey times.

By making these changes permanent it will continue to provide two free-flowing traffic lanes for use by all vehicles travelling northbound between Conyers Avenue and Nuns Corner.
