

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
A SECTION OF WOAD LANE, GREAT COATES, GRIMSBY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– TTRO 21-056) ORDER 2021

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle to proceed along the below sections of highway:

- A section of WOAD LANE – Part Length from its junction with HOLME FARM CLOSE to its junction with STATION ROAD

Alternative route: STATION ROAD, A1136 GREAT COATES ROAD, A1136 YARBOROUGH ROAD, BOULEVARD AVENUE, PYEWIPE ROAD, A180 WB, ESTATE ROAD No1, WOAD LANE, and the reverse route

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by NELC STREETLIGHTING. These works are detailed as works to replace a street lighting column.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Wednesday, 21 April 2021** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1), A Section of Woad Lane, Great Coates, Grimsby, (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 21-056), Order 2021"
