To encourage Local Authorities to support businesses as quickly as possible, Government announced in April 2021 that Local Authorities who could defray all of their Covid-19 Additional Restrictions Grant by 30th June 2021 (subsequently extended to 31st July 2021) would be eligible to draw down a further allocation which can be used for wider business support activities. NELC were able to meet this target and have subsequently been awarded a further £891,622 which must be defrayed by 31st March 2022.

4. Details of Decision Required

That Cabinet notes the award of additional funding.

That Cabinet delegates authority to the Executive Director for Environment, Economy and Resources to defray Phase 3 Assisted Restrictions Grant (ARG) funding through an extension to the Digital Boost Grant, and Capital business grants for equipment or technology, or otherwise at the Executive Director's discretion, which will boost trade for those most affected or create additional jobs.

5. Reasons for Urgency

In order to achieve defrayal by the deadline, the grant scheme will need to launch as soon as possible.
