Statement of Reasons

This Statement of Reasons relates to the making of the following Traffic Regulation Order:

The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (A1173, Kiln Lane, Kings Road and Queens Road) (24 Hour Clearway) (No. 19-25B) Order 2021.

Street(s) affected:

- A1173 Stallingborough
- Kiln Lane, Stallingborough
- A1173 Kings Road, Immingham
- Kings Road, Immingham
- Queens Road, Immingham

Ward(s) affected:

Immingham

Proposal:

- To revoke existing No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on Kings Road, Immingham
- To introduce a 24-hour Clearway restriction covering A1173 and Kiln Lane in Stallingborough, and A1173 Kings Road, Kings Road and Queens Road, in Immingham.

Reason:

The clearway order is required to ensure the efficient and safe movement of traffic along these heavily used routes, and to support the newly constructed Stallingborough Enterprise Zone highway infrastructure.

The usable carriageway width on the A1173 and Kiln Lane will allow traffic to pass a stationary vehicle in the case of a vehicle breakdown, however, parking or stopping on the carriageway is not desirable or sanctioned.

The introduction of a 24 hour clearway will prohibit the stopping of any vehicles, except in an emergency, on the main carriageway, therefore enabling the free flow and unobstructed movement of traffic on all these routes, and will facilitate the continuation of the existing clearway restriction in place on Manby Road, Immingham.

As the clearway restriction will supersede the existing No Waiting at Any Time carriageway restrictions on Kings Road, Immingham these are no longer needed and will therefore be revoked.
