The new proposed change to the permitted boundary Appendix 2 will not affect the storage facility and will remain the same as currently operated. And will not effect the environmental management controls currently in place.

The proposed change to the permitted boundary which will extend the company's ability to service vessels other than 3 Quay Extension, and would permit the discharge of vessels on the adjoining 4 and 5 quay's Immingham Docks.

Therefore, accessing the additional quays would require the extension of the pneumatic induction pipe by 280 metres from the original length of 90 metres.
