THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF LINCOLN, PARTS OF LINDSEY in exercise of their powers under section 11(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1962, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Lincoln and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order as follows:-

- No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on either of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
- The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament
- This Order may be cited as "The County Council of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No.2) Order 1963"



SCHEDULE

LENGTHS OF ROAD IN THE COUNTY OF LINCOLN, PARTS OF LINDSEY STATION ROAD (A.1098) AT NEW WALTHAM:

From its junction with the Norman Cross - Grimsby Trunk Road (A.16) to its junction with Peaks Lane (A.1098) and Humberston Avenue (B.1219), a distance of approximately 1093 yards

HUMBERSTON AVENUE (B.1219) BETWEEN NEW WALTHAM AND HUMBERSTON:

From its junction with Peaks Lane (A.1098) at New Waltham to a point 200 yards west of its junction with the Cleethorpes - Mablethorpe road (A.1031) at Humberston, a distance of approximately 1 mile 520 yards.
