

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
CROSS COATES ROAD, GRIMSBY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– TTRO 21-127) ORDER 2021

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, from **PROCEEDING** along or **STOPPING** on the below sections of highway:

- A section of CROSS COATES ROAD, GRIMSBY – Part Length from its junction with ALLENBY AVENUE to its junction with CLIFTON ROAD.

Alternative route: Cross Coates Road, Littlefield Lane, Chelmsford Avenue, Cambridge Road, Littlecoates Road, Yarborough Road.

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by North East Lincolnshire Council. These works are detailed as carriageway resurfacing.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Saturday, 20 November 2021** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There will be no exemptions to this order due to the nature of the works requiring deep excavation of the carriageway.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1), Cross Coates Road, Grimsby, (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 21-127), Order 2021"
