(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRN 21-144E)
EMERGENCY NOTICE 2021

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle, from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- QUEENS ROAD, IMMINGHAM – Part length from its junction with LAPORTE ROAD to a point no more than 280 metres southwest of the QUEENS ROAD RAILWAY BRIDGE, incorporating the bridge itself.

Alternative route: QUEENS ROAD, LAPORTE ROAD, KILN LANE, A1173, KINGS ROAD

This emergency prohibition is required to undertake, or where necessary, arrange for the emergency repair of bridge expansion joints.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Notice shall come into operation on **Friday, 03 December 2021** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Thursday, 23 December 2021**.
