**WABY CLOSE, GRIMSBY**

**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– TTRO 21-124) ORDER 2021**

**WHEREAS** the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- A section of WABY CLOSE, GRIMSBY – Part Length from its most southern junction with LAMOUR ROAD in a north easterly direction for a distance of no more than 25 metres.

Alternative route: LAMOUR ROAD, WABY CLOSE (northern junction).

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Anglian Water. These works are detailed as the installation of a new pressure relief meter.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday, 10 January 2022** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Authorised Contractors / Utilities / Waste

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1), Waby Close, Grimsby, (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 21-124), Order 2021"
