

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
HABROUGH LEVEL CROSSING, BROCKLESBY ROAD (HABROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC– TTRO 21-141) ORDER 2021

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, from **PROCEEDING** along or **STOPPING** on the below sections of highway:

- A section of BROCKLESBY ROAD, HABROUGH – Part Length that being HABROUGH LEVEL CROSSING, including 20 metres either side of the crossing.

Alternative route: B1210 STATION ROAD, B1210 IMMINGHAM ROAD, B1210 HABROUGH ROAD, B1210 STALLINGBOROUGH ROAD, A1173 RIBY ROAD, A18 BARTON STREET, B1211, B1211 BROCKLESBY ROAD, B1210 BROCKLESBY

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Network Rail. These works are detailed as vegetation cutting using flail.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Saturday, 15 January 2022** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There will be no exemptions to this Order.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Habrough Level Crossing, Brocklesby Road (Habrough), (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 21-141), Order 2021"
