CB.96 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

CB.97 **TOLL BAR JUNCTION IMPROVEMENT**

Cabinet considered the deliberations of the Working Group on the Toll Bar junction improvement scheme. The Working Group met on 15th and 16th January 2018 to consider options for the delivery of the project following a resolution of Full Council on 30th November 2017.

RESOLVED -

- (1) That the findings of the Working Group into the Toll Bar junction improvement scheme be received.
- (2) That the Cabinet decision of 15th February 2017 to proceed with the implementation of a signalised crossroads junction with appropriate pedestrian/cycle safety measures, be endorsed.
- (3) That the Director for Economy and Growth be authorised to instruct the Council's Regeneration Partner ENGIE to put appropriate measures in place to minimise the impact of the works on the highway network and the affected communities, and to make regular reports on progress to the Portfolio Holder for Energy and Environment and the relevant Scrutiny Panel.
