ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT
DECISION NOTICE**

At the meeting of the Portfolio Holder – Energy and Environment, held on the 20th February, 2017 the following matters were discussed. The decisions of the Portfolio Holder are set out below in each item along with reasons for the decision and other options considered.

DNPH.EE.42 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interests in respect of items on the agenda.

DNPH.EE.43 PETITION – EDWARD STREET, RESIDENT PARKING SCHEME

RESOLVED – That, the petition be received and the situation on Edward Street be assessed for suitability for a Residents Parking Scheme.

REASONS FOR DECISION - In response to the petition.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED - None

DNPH.EE.44 **LOCAL TRANSPORT PLAN CAPITAL PROGRAMME (QUARTER 3 MEMBERS UPDATE)**

The Portfolio Holder considered a report on the progress made in developing the NELC Local Transport Plan (LTP) capital programme during the first three quarters of 2016/17.

RESOLVED –

- (1) That the Local Transport Plan Quarter 3 Members Update be noted and its circulation to all Members for information be approved.**
- (2) That the Local Transport Plan Quarter 3 be sent for information to the Regeneration, Environment and Housing Scrutiny Panel.**

REASONS FOR DECISION –

To ensure transparency in the delivery of the Council's Local Transport Plan and provide an opportunity for formal challenge of the programme.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED –

Do nothing, and not amend the Local Transport Plan programme: Opportunities to minimise disruption would be missed resulting in increased levels of disruption for residents and possible higher scheme costs.

DNPH.EE.45 **APPROVAL OF LOCAL TRANSPORT PLAN DELIVERY PLAN 2017-2020 INCLUDING CAPITAL PROGRAMME 2017/18 AND 2018/19**

The Portfolio Holder considered a report which sets out the proposed Local Transport Plan Capital Programme for the years 2017/18 and 2018/19 plus a list of indicative schemes for 2019/20 onwards.

RESOLVED – That the attached Delivery Plan (appendix 1) including the Local Transport Plan Capital Programme for 2017/18 and 2018/19 be approved.

REASONS FOR DECISION –

In order that the 2017/18 LTP capital programme can progress and to ensure transparency in the delivery of the Council's Local Transport Plan.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED –

When developing the LTP programme, Programme Managers consider a wide range of schemes, taking into account the likely impact on the LTP Transport Challenges as well as other criteria specific to individual programme areas. In doing so, they develop a comprehensive list of schemes that address our responsibilities as a local highway authority and support the delivery of the emerging Local Plan, Economic Strategy and Town Centre Investment plans.

A second “do nothing” was considered, however taking this approach would result in a significant delay in delivering the LTP capital programme which in turn may result in the LTP programme not being delivered with the associated reputational harm to the Council.

DNPH.EE.46 **TRACKING**

The Portfolio Holder considered a report tracking the recommendations of previous meetings.

RESOLVED –

- (1) That in relation to DNPH.ET.3 – Petition on School Initiative Road Safety - Install pedestrian crossing on Alexandra road, Grimsby, this item has now been completed and can be taken off the tracking report.**
- (2) That in relation to DNPH.ET.38 taken on 19th January 2016, which was to consult the public on a new Conservation Area Appraisal for Great Coates conservation area. This decision can now be marked as completed as numerous representations were received to keep Great Coates conservation area as it was. Therefore, the appraisal will no longer be going ahead.**

DNPH.EE.47 **URGENT BUSINESS - ROAD SAFETY, STALLINGBOROUGH CHURCH OF ENGLAND SCHOOL**

The Portfolio holder received a petition on Traffic management and increased road safety around Stallingborough C of E School.

RESOLVED – That, the petition be received and the situation on traffic management and increased road safety around Stallingborough C of E school be assessed.

REASONS FOR DECISION - In response to the petition.
