PH.FR.2 REGULATION OF INVESTIGATORY POWERS ACT 2000 POLICY STATEMENT

The Portfolio Holder considered a report to remove reference to the acquisition of communications data in the policy as this was no longer permissible under RIPA legislation.

Mr Edwards explained that the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act (RIPA) policy statement set out the Council's commitment to the lawful use of those powers. Changes to legislation removed the ability for public authorities to obtain communications data under the RIPA. Therefore, the policy statement had been reviewed to reflect this.

RESOLVED – That the revised Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000 policy statement be approved and published on the Council's website.
