- (2) That in relation to DPH.EE.6 (Petition for the maintenance schedule for public grassed areas in Cleethorpes) it be noted that the petition had now been considered by the Street Scene Select Committee and they believed that the request for improvements to the grass cutting in Cleethorpes had been addressed within the review of the grounds maintenance service report. The Overview and Scrutiny Committee had endorsed these recommendations and they had now been referred to Cabinet for approval as part of the Grounds Maintenance review.
- (3) That in relation to DNPH.EE.23 (Petition for parking conditions on Bolingbroke Road, Cleethorpes) it had been noted that the seasonal parking scheme would be part of the 2020/21 delivery programme and this would be subject to formal decision at a forthcoming meeting of this Portfolio Holder.
