### PH.ETE.22 TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS – 2019 WORKS PROGRAMME

The Portfolio Holder considered a report that identified the proposed works programme for Traffic Regulation Orders to be delivered in 2019 in accordance with North East Lincolnshire Council's Traffic Regulation Orders guidance document.

## PH.ETE.23 REVIEW OF FEES AND CHARGES IN WASTE, STREET CLEANSING, FLEET, BEREAVEMENT SERVICES AND GROUNDS MAINTENANCE

The Portfolio Holder considered a report that proposed a review of fees and charges to ensure that the Council maintains its income base with rising cost and generates additional resources to support provision of services within the agreed budget envelope.

The Portfolio Holder noted that he intended to defer decisions around increases to grounds maintenance fees and charges to allow further consultation with sports clubs and community groups.

# PH.ETE.24 TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER: STALLINGBOROUGH VILLAGE EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

The Portfolio Holder considered a report that proposed to make permanent the current experimental traffic regulation order for 'No Waiting, 8am - 9am and 3pm - 4pm Monday to Friday' on Station Road, in the vicinity of Stallingborough Primary School, and 'No Waiting at Any Time' at the junction of Station Road and Clarkson Drive, Stallingborough.

RESOLVED – That approval be granted to give permanent effect to the Experimental Traffic Regulation Order TR17-43 in Stallingborough village, as listed in Appendix 1 of the report now submitted and shown on drawing ETRO: 17-107139-02.

### PH.ETE.25 TRACKING REPORT

On the petition for a pedestrian crossing in Stallingborough, Ms Swatman noted that this was in the Local Transport Plan programme due to come forward for approval in March, 2019.
