

**PORTFOLIO HOLDER
ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT
DECISION NOTICE**

At the meeting of the Portfolio Holder – Energy and Environment, held on the 6th February, 2018 the following matters were discussed. The decisions of the Portfolio Holder are set out below in each item along with reasons for the decision and other options considered.

DNPH.EE.34 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interests in respect of items on the agenda.

DNPH.EE.35 TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – 24 HOUR CLEARWAY MANBY ROAD (A1173), IMMINGHAM

The Portfolio Holder received a report that introduces a Traffic Regulation Order for a '24 hour Clearway' on the section of A1173 Manby Road, Immingham to provide a continuation of the existing restriction within North Lincolnshire to prevent vehicles from stopping on this high speed road.

RESOLVED –

- (1) That subject to no objections being received, approval be granted to the making of a “24 hour Clearway” Traffic Regulation Order as listed in the Schedule given in Appendix 1 and shown on drawings TRO17-07/1 and TRO17-07/2.**
- (2) That in the event that there were unresolved objections to the Order, these were referred back to the Portfolio Holder for determination and decision as to whether or not the Traffic Regulation Order be confirmed.**

Reasons for decision –

- To improve the safe passage of vehicles along the A1173 for all road users.
- To prevent vehicles (in particular HGVs) from parking on this section of the a1173.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED – The area concerned could be left as unrestricted. However, this would not be supported by Humberside Police who have identified safety concerns around obstruction of the highway affecting the free flow of traffic and poor visibility particularly around access to and from industrial premises located on the high speed section of the A1173, leading to near miss reports. Given the class of vehicles and the speed of traffic using the dual carriageway in particular, it was recommended that the Council address these concerns.
