**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)**  
**GREAT COATES LEVEL CROSSING – WOAD LANE, GRIMSBY**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 22-027) ORDER 2022**

**WHEREAS** the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- A section of WOAD LANE, GRIMSBY – Part Length from its junction with STATION ROAD, GREAT COATES to a point 20 metres north of GREAT COATES LEVEL CROSSING.

Alternative route: STATION ROAD, A1136 GREAT COATES ROAD, A1136, A180, ESTATE ROAD 1, WOAD LANE

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Network Rail. These works are detailed as level crossing maintenance.

Works will be undertaken overnight between 23:30hrs and 08:30hrs to minimise disruption to the public.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Saturday, 28 May 2022** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There will be no Exemptions to this order on the grounds of safety.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Great Coates Level Crossing – Woad Lane, Grimsby, (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic – TTRO 22-027), Order 2022"
