## THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(2) DURBAN ROAD, GRIMSBY (PART) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRN 22-078E) EMERGENCY NOTICE 2022

<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

• DURBAN ROAD, GRIMSBY (PART) – from its junction with ROBERTS STREET to its junction with HUMBERSTONE ROAD.

This emergency prohibition is required in order for works to be safely undertaken to repair a burst water main.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Notice shall come into operation on **Tuesday**, **28 June 2022** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **04 July 2022**.
