THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a) BROCKLESBY ROAD, HABROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 22-101) ORDER 2022

<u>WHEREAS</u> the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle, pedestrian or pedal cycle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

 A section of BROCKLESBY ROAD – Part Length from a point 20 metres south of HABROUGH LEVEL CROSSING to a point 20 metres north-east of HABROUGH ROAD LEVEL CROSSING

Alternative route: B1210 STATION ROAD (HABROUGH), B1210 IMMINGHAM ROAD, B1210 HABROUGH ROAD, B1210 STALLINGBOROUGH ROAD, A1173 STALLINGBOROUGH ROAD, A1173 RIBY ROAD, A18 BARTON STREET, B1211, B1211 BROCKLESBY ROAD, B1210 BROCKLESBY

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Network Rail. These works are detailed as rail depth inspections at Habrough Level Crossing.

Works will be undertaken overnight between 23:00hrs and 06:00hrs to minimise disruption to traffic.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday**, **03 October 2022** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There are no Exemptions to the Order on the grounds of safety.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Brocklesby Road, Habrough, (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 22-101), Order 2022"
