

**The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council
(Prohibition of Driving – Except Permit Holders)
(School Streets Phase 1 - Various Streets) (No. 22-06)
Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 2022**

Notice is hereby given that on **17th November 2022** North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be as follows:-

1. To trial the introduction of a Prohibition of Driving – Except for Permit Holders (School Street) restriction on the full extent of the following roads, during the following times:

Monday to Friday between 8.30 - 9.00am and 2.45 – 3.45pm

- South Parade, Grimsby (Ormiston South Parade Academy)
- Macaulay Street, Grimsby (Macaulay Primary Academy)

Monday to Friday between 8.30 - 9.00am and 3.00 – 4.00pm

- Machray Place, Cleethorpes (Reynolds Academy)
- Allerton Drive, Immingham (Pilgrim Academy)

The Order will come into force on **5th December 2022**.

The Order Making Authority will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental order should be continued in force indefinitely.

Within a period of six months, beginning with the day on which the experimental order came into force, or if this Order is varied by another order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force, any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation.

Persons wishing to object to these proposals may do so quoting reference 22-06 and stating the grounds on which the objection is made, by writing to the address below or electronically by using the 'Traffic Regulation Order Consultation Form'. The full website address is:-

If any person wishes to challenge the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
