Statement of Reasons

This Statement of Reasons relate to the making of the following Parking Places Order:

North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2022

Parking Place(s) affected:

 All parking places listed in the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2012 as amended

Ward(s) affected:

Proposal:

 Introduction of a new Off Street Parking Places order: 'North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2022'

Reason:

The reason for the proposed Order is due to a review of various aspects of parking provision across the borough and a number of additions to the current off-street parking orders which are required to enable effective operational management and enforcement of council car parks.

- A number of parking place locations, require either being removed from the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places)
 Order 2012 and any subsequent amendment Orders, or they are to be relisted with a new title
- Makes provision for an alternative method of payment by the introduction of 'Cashless' parking as an additional option for payment (pay by phone or mobile application)

- Phase out business permits in Cleethorpes at £102.13 a year and replace with Single Use Season Tickets
 - First year £225
 - Second year £450
 - New customers £450
 - Reserved bays £450 from the next annual renewal
- Introduction of a maximum four-hour stays, for vehicles parked within Electric Vehicle (EV) only parking bays
- The inclusion of four reserved visitor parking bays to Civic Offices forecourt, with an allowance of two hours free stay. Enforcement of the forecourt to be brought into scope with 'staff permit' holders, enforceable Monday to Friday. Closed by gates over the weekend period and Bank Holidays
- Revised range of Season Tickets with the creation of a single use season ticket and savers season ticket options at a cost £450 and £250, respectively.
- General season tickets will increase from £663.63 to £670 with the addition of further eligible car parks
- Proposed amendments to the class of vehicles permitted in the council car parks. This is specific to Camper Vans and Motor Caravans.
