
## Alcohol and Other Drugs Survey Results - 131 responses


- 1. Are you aware of what local alcohol and drug services offer?

The following are the results in charts with some explanation of some of the details provided by those who took part in the survey




1. Are you aware of what local alcohol and drug services offer?

3. Do alcohol and drug services fail to support any groups of people?


