

THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
CHELMSFORD AVENUE, GRIMSBY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 22-142) ORDER 2022

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- A section of CHELMSFORD AVENUE – Part Length from a point adjacent to property No. 31 CHELMSFORD AVENUE to a point adjacent to property No. 37 CHELMSFORD AVENUE.
Alternative route: CROSS COATES ROAD, A1136 YARBOROUGH ROAD, B144 LITTLE COATES ROAD, CAMBRIDGE ROAD.

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by Anglian Water. These works are detailed as the installation of new valves on water main.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Monday, 12 December 2022** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

There are no Exemptions to the Order on the grounds that there is insufficient carriageway width to allow vehicles to pass safely.

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Chelmsford Avenue, Grimsby (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 22-142), Order 2022"

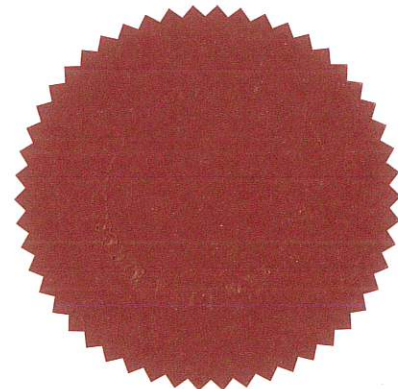
