(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRN 22-187E)
EMERGENCY NOTICE 2023

WHEREAS the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following **Emergency Notice** the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- CURRY ROAD – Part length, from its junction with A1136 YARBOROUGH ROAD to its junction with FLETCHER ROAD.

Alternative route: FLETCHER ROAD, YARROW ROAD, A1136 YARBOROUGH ROAD (reverse route applies)

This emergency prohibition is required to enable Cadent Gas to safely trace, excavate, repair a gas escape, then reinstate.

Access for Emergency Vehicles and refuse collections will be maintained.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Notice shall come into operation on **Monday, 16 January 2023** and shall continue for a period of 21 days unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport. The closure is expected to remain in place until **Friday, 20 January 2023**.
