## The North East LincoInshire Borough Council (Hobson Way & Laporte Road, Stallingborough) (24 Hour Clearway) (No. 21-02) Order 2021

Notice is hereby given that on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2023 North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to: -

- To introduce a 24-hour Clearway along the following lengths of road;
- 1. Hobson Way, Stallingborough from the roundabout junction with Energy Park Way, including the roundabout, to its roundabout junction with Kiln Lane and Laporte Road.
- 2. Laporte Road, Stallingborough from its roundabout junction with Kiln Lane and Hobson Way, including the roundabout, to its junction with Queens Road, Immingham.

The Order will come into force on the **10<sup>th</sup> February 2023**.
