

**THE NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)**  
**GRIMSBY ROAD, LACEBY**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – TTRO 22-191) ORDER 2023**

**WHEREAS** the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby make the following Order the effect of which will be that **no person shall cause or permit** any motor vehicle from **PROCEEDING** along the below sections of highway:

- A section of GRIMSBY ROAD – Part Length, from a point adjacent to the eastern kerbline of CHURCH LANE to a point adjacent to the eastern property boundary of No.1 GRIMSBY ROAD.

Alternative route: The south-east and western carriageway running lanes that border the triangular parking area in Laceby Square.

This temporary prohibition is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road by NELC Transport Team. These works are detailed as the reinstatement of a bus shelter.

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply in the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

The Order shall come into operation on **Wednesday, 22 February 2023** and shall continue for a period of eighteen months unless extended by Order of the Secretary of State for Transport.

Exemptions to the order will be for authorised vehicles only, as listed below.

- Emergency Vehicles (Fire, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard)
- Authorised Contractors

The Order may be cited as "The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)(a), Grimsby Road, Laceby, (Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic – TTRO 22-191), Order 2023"
