

The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council
(Prohibition of Waiting Restrictions) (Various Streets)
(No. 22-08) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given that on 19th April 2023 North East Lincolnshire Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to: -

1. Introduce “24 Hour Prohibition of Waiting” restrictions at the following locations:
 - The junction of Beacon Avenue with The Gatherums, Cleethorpes
 - The full extent of Fauconberg Avenue, Grimsby
 - A section of Ferriby Lane from its junction with Fauconberg Avenue, Grimsby
 - A section of Pelham Avenue, Grimsby where it intersects with Fauconberg Avenue.
 - The junction of Woodlands Avenue, Immingham with Manby Road
 - The junction of Ferndown Drive, Immingham with Woodlands Avenue.

The Order will come into force on the **29th May 2023**.

If any person wishes to challenge the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
